

415 Walnut Collective Fund



History of 415 Walnut Street

Located at 415 Walnut Street is the historic Walnut Street Baptist Church: an architectural treasure built in 1907 by Clinton P. Shockley. The building has been home to the Walnut Street Baptist congregation and the Faith Temple Baptist congregation and was individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2000. The church's most recent congregation moved to a new location in 2010 and the building has remained vacant since that time. In 2019, Iowa Heartland Habitat for Humanity purchased the church to hold and protect the building while community stakeholders collaborated to form the 415 Walnut Collective. In an effort to preserve, renovate, and revitalize the space, the Collective began the visioning process and developed a reuse plan to bring the community's new vision of the building to life.

Vision for the Future

The Collective recognizes the abundance of activity in the neighborhood and aims for 415 Walnut Street to be a public space where people can gather to enjoy, learn, and reflect culture through art, music, food, and history. This neighborhood is an ecosystem where the community is connected and neighbors value building new memories, fostering dreams, and strengthening imagination.
