
Think about what matters to you. Of course you care about the needs of your loved ones, but what about your community and causes you support or have always wanted to support?



# **Making a Charitable Plan**

Making a difference for the causes you care about is easy. The first step is deciding you want to leave a legacy of good for your community. Once you make that decision, the Community Foundation can help guide you the rest of the way.

1. Talk to your advisor. The Community Foundation of Northeast Iowa recommends you discuss your plan to leave a charitable planned gift with your attorney or financial advisor. They can help you incorporate your gift into your personal financial plans.

- 2. Meet with us. Foundation staff have in-depth knowledge of nonprofits in the communities we serve. We help you identify options that support your passion, and create a plan to meet your charitable wishes, supporting the cause or causes you care about most, forever.
- 3. Document your intent. By signing a simple, non-legally binding memorandum of gift through the Community Foundation. Having your donor intent in writing assures we can best carry out your wishes and recognize you accordingly.

#### **Barbara and Bill Clark Barbara and Bill Clark Fund**

The Clarks established the Barbara and Bill Clark Fund during their lifetime, recommending grants to nonprofits they loved that created a stronger Cedar Valley. The couple, who met in 1951 while Bill was at Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts and moved back to Bill's home of Waterloo in 1952, had a vision of generosity that exceeded their lifetimes.

When Barbara passed away in 2009, preceded in death by Bill in 2005. the Barbara and Bill Clark Fund became an unrestricted fund, adding more grant funds to the Black Hawk County discretionary grant process. The generous couple had great faith in the Community Foundation, which Bill believed was, "One of the greatest assets in the Cedar Valley."

Today, the couple's legacy lives on through their endowed fund which supports CFNEIA grantmaking to organizations making Black Hawk County stronger for all people.
